
Mission Statement

THE RICHNESS OF LIFE IN CHRIST

Today we have the beautiful story of the woman who promised a child, the wonderful exhortation about life in Christ, and a powerful instruction from Jesus. An embarrassment of riches? Christ's resurrection is not merely a story about something that he underwent once upon a time, but it is our story, the story of how we joined the other members of the one Body of Christ, the church. We were not only dead, but we were buried; not ultimately buried, but raised to eternal life with Christ.



They believe a sound education, Catholic leadership training and the empowerment of women will enable their children to break the cycle of poverty and superstition, becoming leaders on both local and national levels.


La segunda colecta para la próxima semana será para la Cooperativa Misionera: La provincia de California de las Hermanas de Notre Dame está agradecida de tener la oportunidad de presentar su misión en Buseesa, Uganda a los feligreses de la Misión Santa Ines. La Hermana Rebekah Kennedy y La Hermana Judeen Julier compartirán con ustedes nuestra historia de misión.

En 1998, las Hermanas de Notre Dame abrieron la Escuela Primaria St. Julie y en 2006, la Escuela Secundaria Notre Dame Academy para niñas en el distrito de Kibaale en Uganda. Debido a los métodos subdesarrollados de agricultura, infraestructura deficiente, falta de transporte e inestabilidad política, el ingreso por cápita es muy bajo. Ellos creen que una educación sana, la capacitación del liderazgo católico y el empoderamiento de las mujeres permitirán a sus hijos romper el ciclo de pobreza y superstición, convirtiéndose en líderes tanto a nivel local como nacional.

El crecimiento de nuestra misión Ugandesa es posible debido a la generosidad de miles de individuos y grupos. Gracias por darnos la oportunidad de presentarles nuestra misión, ¡esperamos conocerlos pronto!

LA RIQUEZA DE LA VIDA EN CRISTO


