Hoy, mientras lidiamos con la pandemia de COVID-19, cabe destacar que el Centro Nacional para Niños Desaparecidos y Explotados (NCMEC, por sus siglas en inglés) informó que la seguridad de los niños también se ha visto afectada como resultado de la pandemia de COVID-19. “En 2021, el NCMEC declaró que había experimentado un aumento del 97.5 por ciento en los informes de seducción en línea entre enero de 2020 y diciembre de 2020, en comparación con el mismo período de 2019”. El NCMEC mantiene una línea directa las 24 horas en el 1-800-843-5678, y CyberTipline recibe informes de incidentes de explotación sexual infantil a través de un formulario en línea en <https://report.cybertip.org/>.
