FROM OUR PASTOR

In this Sunday's Gospel, we find Jesus beginning his public life in a region of Galilee, which the prophet Isaiah calls "Galilee of the Gentiles," a peripheral area despised by the most observant Jews due to the presence of various foreign populations. Today we find ourselves surrounded by different cultures, political affiliations, and social strata; we are immersed daily in a "Galilee of the Gentiles." The Good News that Jesus brings is not reserved for a part of humanity but must be communicated to all that no one is excluded from God's salvation; indeed, God prefers to start from the periphery, from the last, to reach everyone. We also see Jesus calling simple people to follow him, fishermen, who immediately follow him. In the same way, The Lord also calls you today, and He passes through the paths of our daily life. He calls us to go with him, to work with him for the kingdom of God, in the "Galilees" of our times; every Christian will discern the path the Lord asks of him. Still, we are all invited to accept this call, leave our comfort, and dare to reach all the peripheries that need the light of the Gospel. The Lord never disappoints; let us allow ourselves to be reached by his gaze, by his voice, and follow him "So that the joy of the Gospel may reach the ends of the earth, and no periphery be deprived of its light."

Hoy nos encontramos rodeados de diferentes culturas, filiaciones políticas y estratos sociales; estamos sumergidos diariamente en una "Galilea de los gentiles". La Buena Noticia que trae Jesús no está reservada a una parte de la humanidad sino que debe ser comunicada a todos para que nadie quede excluido de la salvación de Dios; es mas, Dios prefiere partir de la periferia, de los últimos, para llegar a todos. Tambien, vemos a Jesús llamando a la gente sencilla a seguirlo, a los pescadores, que lo siguen inmediatamente. De Igual manera, el Señor también nos llama hoy, y pasa por los caminos de nuestra vida cotidiana. Nos llama a ir con Él, a trabajar con Él por el reino de Dios, en las "Galileas" de nuestro tiempo; cada cristiano discernirá el camino que el Señor le pide. Aún así, todos estamos invitados a acoger esta llamada de salir de nuestra comodidad y atrevernos a llegar a todas las periferias que necesitan la luz del Evangelio. El Señor nunca defrauda; dejémonos alcanzar por su mirada, por su voz, y sigámoslo "para que la alegría del Evangelio llegue hasta los confines de la tierra, y ninguna periferia quede privada de su luz".
