**A note about COVID-19 vaccination.** From a statement by Bishop Michael Barber, SJ, of Oakland: The Vatican has stated the connection with aborted fetal tissue is remote enough that it is morally permissible to take the vaccine. Therefore, since the Catholic Church has formally recommended its members receive the vaccine, a "religious exemption" would not apply to Catholics. The Church also teaches people should not be forced to take the vaccine against their will.... If some Catholics feel it is against their conscience to take the vaccine, that is a decision between them and God. While the Church teaches people should follow their consciences, a priest or bishop may not sign a "religious exemption" for a *conscientious* objection. They are two different things. As faithful Catholics and responsible citizens, we have the moral and civil obligation to protect the well-being of our society. To get vaccinated is to protect ourselves, our neighbors and to help stop the spread of this deadly virus.

**Octubre es Mes del Respeto a la Vida.** Durante este mes consideramos más profundamente por qué cada vida humana es valiosa, y reflexionamos sobre cómo construir una cultura que proteja la vida desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural.

**Una Nota sobre la vacuna del COVID-19.** De una declaración del obispo Michael Barber, SJ, de Oakland: El Vaticano ha declarado que la probabilidad de conexión entre la vacuna y el tejido fetal abortado es suficientemente remota, que es moralmente permisible tomar la vacuna. Por lo tanto, dado que la Iglesia Católica ha recomendado formalmente a sus miembros recibir la vacuna, una "exención religiosa" no se aplicaría a los católicos. La Iglesia también enseña que no se debe obligar a las personas a tomar la vacuna contra su voluntad.... Si un católico siente que es contra su conciencia tomar la vacuna, esa es una decisión entre ellos y Dios. La Iglesia enseña que las personas deben seguir sus conciencias. Pero un sacerdote u obispo no puede firmar una "exención religiosa" para una objeción de conciencia. Son dos cosas diferentes. Como fieles católicos y ciudadanos responsables, tenemos la obligación moral y civil de proteger el bienestar de nuestra sociedad. Vacunarnos es protegernos a nosotros mismos, a nuestros vecinos y ayudar a detener la propagación de este virus mortal.

**¿SABÍA USTED? Qué hacer antes de administrar primeros auxilios a bebés o niños.** Cuando un niño o un bebé experimenta una crisis médica, es importante darle atención y buscar ayuda lo antes posible. Pero debido a que sus cuerpos aún se están formando, y son más delicados y más compactos que los de un adulto, dar primeros auxilios a niños o a bebés es distinto a darle atención a un adulto.
