FROM OUR PASTOR

Last week our readings spoke of gratitude or thankfulness. This week we hear about prayer. Bridging the two themes, we hear St Paul say that he offers grateful prayers to God, confident that God who has begun a good work in the faithful will bring it to completion (Phil 1, 1-6). The translation implies that the Lord works with individual believers and the larger community. How do we have that confidence? Life's struggles can rob our strength and hope. Even Moses struggled with his mission. He was sustained in prayer and with the support of others. The second reading today (2 Tm) tells us that God's Word sustains us and our confidence. Persistence and steadfastness are also important. God answers prayers-sometimes quickly and sometimes waits for a better time. If I am waiting for a response, do I give time to God in prayer each day? Do I lift others in prayer, especially those who are struggling? Do I pray with others as well as for others? Is God's word our daily bread? Do we pray with the Bible? Have we given up hope because of our struggles or because we must wait for God's response? Today's world can be discouraging-just as it could have been for Paul, Mother Theresa, or Elizabeth Seaton. They were recognized as saints for their lives of prayer and their ministries. May the gifts of prayer and Scripture keep us united to Jesus, and one another, as He completes His work in us.





DE NUESTRO PARROCO

La semana pasada nuestras lecturas hablaban de gratitud o agradecimiento. Esta semana escuchamos acerca de la oración. Uniendo los dos temas, escuchamos a san Pablo decir que ofrece oraciones de agradecimiento a Dios, confiado en que Dios, que ha comenzado una buena obra en los fieles, la llevará a término (Fil 1, 1-6). La traducción implica que el Señor trabaja con creyentes individuales y con la comunidad en general. ¿Cómo tenemos esa confianza? Las luchas de la vida pueden robar nuestra fuerza y esperanza. Incluso Moisés luchó con su misión. Fue sostenido en la oración y con el apoyo de los demás. La segunda lectura de hoy (2 Tm) nos dice que la Palabra de Dios nos sostiene a nosotros y a nuestra confianza. La persistencia y la constancia también son importantes. Dios contesta las oraciones, a veces rápidamente, ya veces espera un mejor momento. Si estoy esperando una respuesta, ¿le doy tiempo a Dios en oración todos los días? ¿Elevo a otros en oración, especialmente a aquellos que están luchando? ¿Oro con los demás así como por los demás? ¿Es la palabra de Dios nuestro pan de cada día? ¿Oramos con la Biblia? ¿Hemos perdido la esperanza debido a nuestras luchas o porque debemos esperar la respuesta de Dios? El mundo de hoy puede ser desalentador, tal como podría haberlo sido para Paul, la Madre Teresa o Elizabeth Seaton. Fueron reconocidos como santos por su vida de oración y sus ministerios. Que los dones de la oración y las Escrituras nos mantengan unidos a Jesús y unos a otros, mientras Él completa su obra en nosotros.
