FROM OUR PASTOR

The Gospel is from St. Matthew 16:13-20. Jesus, the true Son of God, became man in order to make all men His brothers and co-heirs with Him, to the divine, eternal kingdom. To carry on His divine mission on earth (after He had ascended into heaven), He founded the Church on the twelve Apostles.. As its mission was to bring the message of salvation to all men, it was to go on until the end of time. For this Church, this divinely instituted society of human beings, to carry out its mission of helping all men to reach their eternal kingdom, it was necessary to be sure of the road and the aids offered to its members. In making Peter the head of the Apostolic College, the guarantor of its stability in the symbol of the keys and the promise that all his decisions would be ratified in heaven, Christ gave him the power of freedom from error when officially teaching the universal Church.

Peter received the primacy in the Church and the gift of infallibility in his official teaching on matters of faith and morals. As the Church was to continue long after Peter had died, it was rightly understood from the beginning that the privileges given to him and which were necessary for the successful mission of the Church, were given to his lawful successors-the Popes.

This has been the constant belief in the Church from its very beginning. The first Vatican Council solemnly defined this dogma and it was reconfirmed recently in the second Vatican Council. In giving these powers to Peter and to his lawful successors Christ was planning for our needs. In order to preserve and safeguard the right conduct of all its members He provided a central seat of authoritative power in His Church. Through the gift of infallibility, He assured us that whatever we were commanded to believe (faith) or to do (morals) would always be what He and his heavenly Father wanted us to believe and to do.

How can we ever thank Christ for these marvelous gifts to his Church, that is, to us? Let us say a fervent: "thank you, Lord; You have foreseen all our needs and provided for them, grant us the grace to do the little part you ask of us in order to continue our progress on the one direct road to heaven."

El Evangelio es de San Mateo 16:13-20. Jesús, el verdadero Hijo de Dios, se hizo hombre para hacer de todos los hombres sus hermanos y coherederos con Él, del reino divino y eterno. Para llevar a cabo su divina misión en la tierra (después de haber ascendido al cielo), fundó la Iglesia sobre los doce Apóstoles. Como su misión era llevar el mensaje de salvación a todos los hombres, debía continuar hasta el fin del mundo. tiempo. Para que esta Iglesia, esta sociedad de seres humanos divinamente instituida, pudiera llevar a cabo su misión de ayudar a todos los hombres a alcanzar su reino eterno, era necesario estar seguro del camino y de las ayudas ofrecidas a sus miembros. Al hacer de Pedro cabeza del Colegio Apostólico, garante de su estabilidad en el símbolo de las llaves y de la promesa de que todas sus decisiones serían ratificadas en el cielo, Cristo le dio el poder de estar libre del error en la enseñanza oficial de la Iglesia universal. Pedro recibió el primado en la Iglesia y el don de la infalibilidad en su enseñanza oficial en materia de fe y moral. Como la Iglesia continuaría mucho después de la muerte de Pedro, se entendió correctamente desde el principio que los privilegios que se le otorgaron y que eran necesarios para el éxito de la misión de la Iglesia, fueron otorgados a sus legítimos sucesores: los Papas. Esta ha sido la creencia constante en la Iglesia desde sus inicios. El Concilio Vaticano I definió solemnemente este dogma y fue reconfirmado recientemente en el Concilio Vaticano II. Al otorgar estos poderes a Pedro y a sus legítimos sucesores, Cristo estaba planificando nuestras necesidades. Para preservar y salvaguardar la conducta correcta de todos sus miembros, Él proporcionó una sede central de poder autoritativo en Su Iglesia. Mediante el don de la infalibilidad, Él nos aseguró que todo lo que se nos ordenara creer (fe) o hacer (moral) siempre sería lo que Él y su Padre celestial querían que creyéramos y hiciéramos.

¿Cómo podremos agradecer a Cristo por estos maravillosos regalos a su Iglesia, es decir, a nosotros?

Digamos un ferviente: "gracias, Señor; Tú has previsto todas nuestras necesidades y las has previsto, concédenos la gracia de hacer lo poco que nos pides para continuar nuestro progreso en el único camino directo al cielo. "
