Faith calls us to act, speak and pray as Christians at school, in the workplace, marketplace, on public streets, etc. Are there areas of our lives or places where we forget about charity & faith? Jesus calls us to be vigilant, to live out our faith daily—we never know who is watching or listening. Various persecutors spied on the first Christians. They quickly accumulated enough evidence to convict & condemn them. If someone followed us during an average week, what evidence would they find?

DID YOU KNOW? - Far-reaching effects of child abuse

Children who suffer from sexual abuse run a greater risk of negative associated outcomes, not only with their mental health, but also suicidal tendencies, potential future abuse, more cognitive deficits, or lower educational interests and efforts. Abused children also are at higher risk for eating disorders, obesity, early onset of puberty, or chronic health issues. Ultimately, abuse has far-reaching consequences beyond childhood for many victims, and it is critical to act quickly to protect potential victims.
