This Sunday's readings remind me of a joke I heard. A person asked, "does anyone know the difference between ignorance and apathy?" Another person answered: "I don't know, and I don't care." Ignorance is dangerous. Apathy is worse. As limited humans, we are ignorant of many things. If we don't care, we become a danger to ourselves and others. In every age, sages share wisdom by speaking, by conversing. In the first reading, a frustrated God speaks to His people saying, "If only you would heed the voice of the Lord your God...it is not too mysterious and remote for you." The Lord asks, "why are we so apathetic, so slow to listen to Him? Doctors, engineers, teachers, psychologists all tell us that too much screen time impedes the brain's ability to reason, memorize, pray, and imagine. Children who spend too much time in front of cell phones, tablets, laptops, desktops, etc., don't develop such abilities. During this vacation season, do we still recognize our need for God's wisdom? Do we care enough to listen to the Lord and others. Are our screens impediments to overcoming ignorance and apathy?

About the Vincentian Congregation The Vincentian Congregation has been working in East Africa for over 40 years, with initial work in Tanzania. In Uganda, the Vincentians established a major retreat center in Entebbe, and in Kenya, the Vincentians operate two retreat centers reaching over 3,000 people weekly. The congregation expanded their efforts to Rwanda over four years ago, founding the Divine Retreat Centre (DRC), Rwanda. DRC serves 2,500 - 3,000 individuals monthly, assisting with the spiritual, physical and educational needs of children, adults, and families, via live-in retreats, outreach programs, one-day prayer services, children's programs, a monthly food and clothing distribution program, an orphanage for refugees, and the administration of a Catholic School serving 1,400+ of the poorest children in the region.

DID YOU KNOW? - What makes a child feel safe enough to disclose abuse?

There are several factors that contribute to whether a child is comfortable disclosing abuse to an adult. Children are more likely to talk about problems when they: have access to an adult they can trust; are able to understand that what is happening to them is not normal or safe; and trust that they will be believed. Another factor that may help a child disclose abuse is when a safe adult is intentional and asks direct questions about a child's life as it communicates caring and attention to the child's life circumstances. Acerca de la Congregación Vicenciana La Congregación Vicenciana ha estado trabajando en África Oriental durante más de 40 años, con trabajo inicial en Tanzania. En Uganda, los vicencianos establecieron un importante centro de retiro en Entebbe, y en Kenia, los vicencianos operan dos centros de retiro que atienden a más de 3.000 personas semanalmente. La congregación amplió sus esfuerzos a Ruanda hace más de cuatro años, fundando el Centro de Retiro Divino (RDC), Ruanda. La República Democrática del Congo atiende a entre 2500 y 3000 personas mensualmente, asistiendo con las necesidades espirituales, físicas y educativas de niños, adultos y familias, a través de retiros en vivo, programas de extensión, servicios de oración de un día, programas para niños, un programa mensual de distribución de alimentos y ropa, un orfanato para refugiados y la administración de una escuela católica que atiende a más de 1400 de los niños más pobres de la región.

¿SABÍAS? - ¿Qué hace que un niño se sienta bastante seguro para revelar un abuso?

Hay varios factores que contribuyen a que un niño se sienta cómodo revelando un abuso a un adulto. Es más probable que los niños hablen de sus problemas cuando: tienen acceso a un adulto en quien pueden confiar; son capaces de entender que lo que les ocurre no es normal ni seguro; y confían que serán creídos. Otro factor que puede ayudar a un niño a revelar un abuso es cuando un adulto seguro actúa con intención y hace preguntas directas sobre la vida de un niño, transmite cariño y atención a las circunstancias de la vida del niño.
