



Today's Mass is about the saints in Heaven. Are there pictures and statues of saints in your church? Do you know the names of any of the saints?











The Sadducees were trying to trick Jesus so they asked him questions about Heaven. Jesus reminded them that after people die on earth, they go to Heaven and keep living with God.

> Leo means lion and Saint Leo was as brave as a lion to stand up for his beliefs.



When they came to yell at her, she opened her coat to show them that she didn't have any bread—it had turned into a bouquet of flowers!





tell Him that you love Him!








