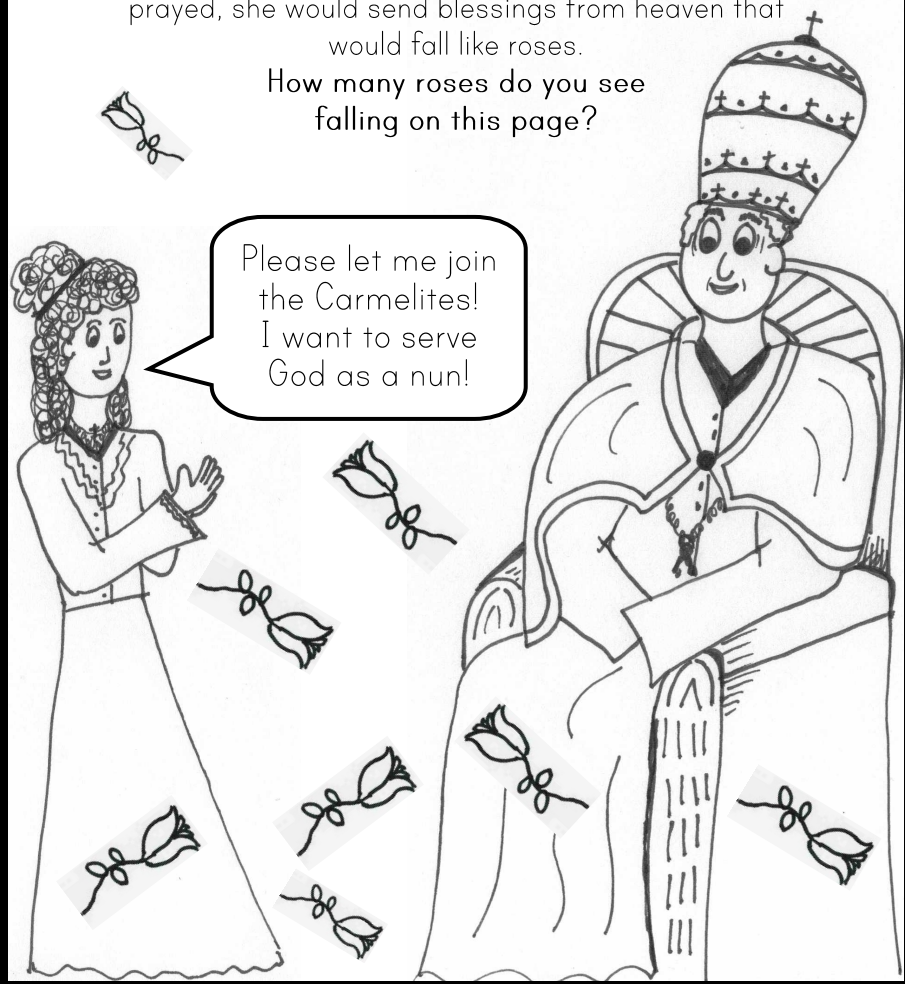
Saint Therese the Little Flower

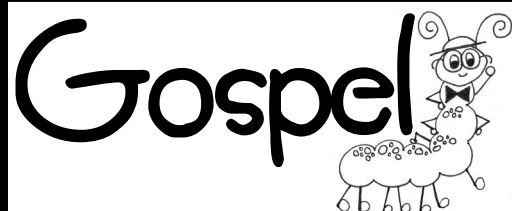
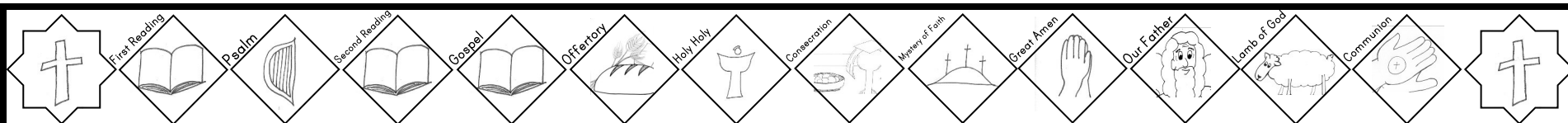

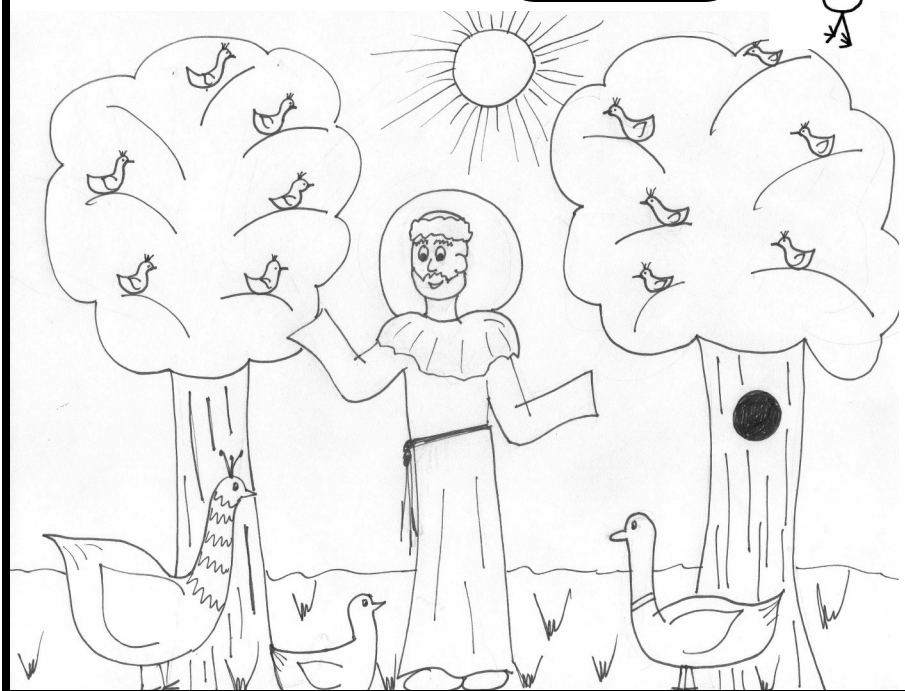
Saint Francis of Assisi

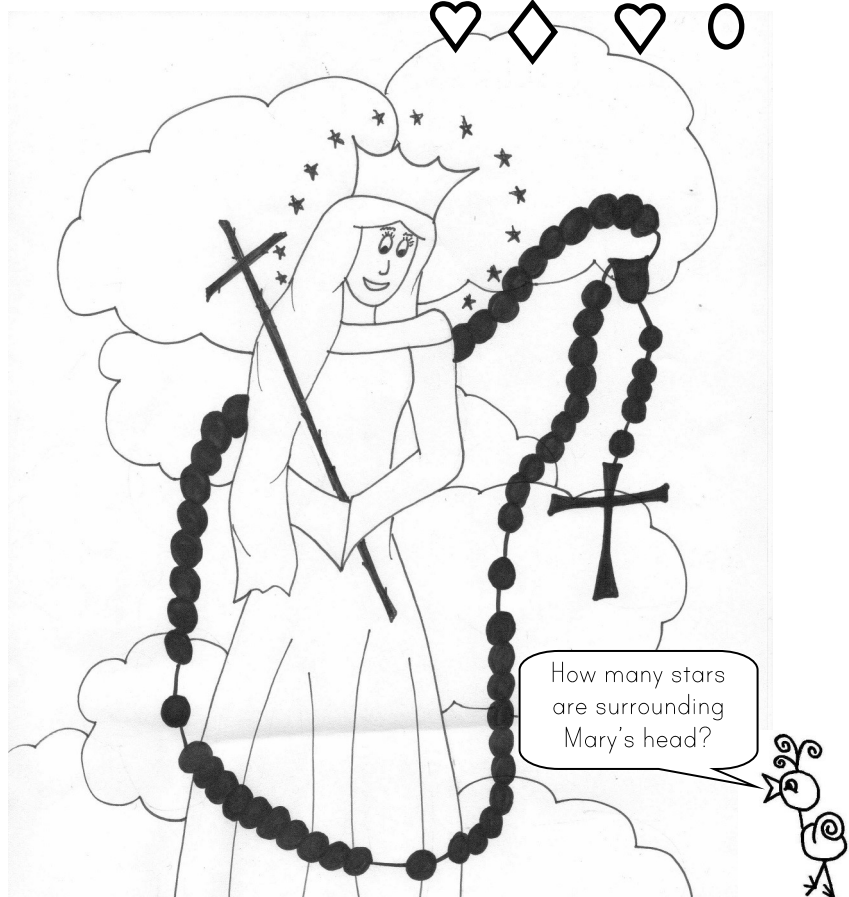
Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary
